



Gospel in Life: Grace Changes Everything

Returning to Pastor Timothy Keller, we will start off the new year with his Gospel in Life DVD series. In it, Keller takes us from considering where we are in the world that is to considering the world that is to come.

Through the Gospels he examines such topics as: The World That Is, The Sin Beneath (idolatry), The Context for Change (community), Cultivating the Garden (work), A People for Others (justice), and others. The Jesus I Never Knew

Philip Yancey is best known for his books on grace. But his central question in this DVD series, according to the publisher's description, is "whether we take Jesus seriously enough in our own day and age." It features "film clips of cinematic portrayals" of Jesus. Yancey presents a picture of Jesus as a complex figure who wants us to stretch our faith. Sessions include: The Jesus I Thought I Knew, The Beatitudes and Sermon on the Mount, The Revolutionary Grace, Jesus' Miracles, Jesus' Death and Resurrection, and The Difference Jesus Makes. Offered during Lent, this series might also help stretch our understanding of Jesus and who he is.
